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### ACADEMY PROGRAMME

The Academy Programme provides support to ParaFed Canterbury's leading Para athletes, coaches and officials on their pathway to high performance programmes, and ultimately representing New Zealand at World Championships and the Paralympic Games.

Those selected in the programme will receive a funding grant, have the opportunity to attend academy seminars (such as media training, nutrition and drug free sport education), and have their achievements promoted through the year.

### Expectations of being in the Academy Programme:

- Demonstrate commitment to training and regular competition.
- Update ParaFed Canterbury on competition results and photos.
- Attend academy seminars and sports specific testing.
- **Promote ParaFed Canterbury in interviews, media articles and social media.**

Priority consideration will be given to those coaches who are working with academy athletes or able to deliver sports specific testing.
Officials Scholarship <b>(new for 2020)</b>	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$500 officials grant</li> <li>• Academy seminars</li> <li>• Individual planning meeting</li> </ul>	Officials (disabled or non-disabled) who are officiating Para sport events. This may include, but not limited to officials, referees and classifiers. The scholarship should support their pathway to becoming accredited or qualified as determined by their sports NSO/IF. This may include the costs involved in attending courses.



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### SELECTION CRITERIA FOR COACHES / OFFICIALS

1. Applications must be received by ParaFed Canterbury by **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2019**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Coach / Officials must reside in the ParaFed Canterbury region (including Tasman, West Coast, Canterbury, Mid-Canterbury and South Canterbury).
3. Scholarships are to be used towards furthering coaches / official's skills, qualifications, personal development or education in their chosen sport. This may include attending training courses, events, competitions or mentoring with other coaches / officials.
4. Scholarship recipients maybe required to run coaching sessions or officiate at ParaFed Canterbury events through the year.
5. The selection panel will be looking at a combination of the following when awarding the coach / official scholarships:
  - Coaching / Officiating ability and potential.
  - Commitment to Para sport.
  - Desire to develop and grow as a coach / official.
  - Goals for the future.
  - Professional development plan.
  - And for coaches, the achievements of disabled athletes they are coaching.
6. Priority will be given to supporting coaches / officials who have not received scholarships in the past.
7. Scholarship recipients maybe required to represent ParaFed Canterbury at activities such as official functions, sports, fundraising, social events and guest speaking.
8. An applicant may fulfil all aspects of the selection criteria, but due to there being a limited number of scholarships available, may not be successful.
9. ParaFed Canterbury reserves the right to select coaches/officials who have potential, but do not currently fulfil all aspects of the selection criteria.
10. The Academy Programme, Coach Scholarships, Officials Scholarship and Graham Condon Scholarship recipients will be announced at the ParaFed Canterbury Sports Awards on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

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### CONTRACT OF UNDERSTANDING

This contract of understanding sets out the expectations of ParaFed Canterbury and those coaches / officials selected in the Academy Programme / Scholarships Programme.

1. This contract of understanding will commence, for successful applicants, on the 30<sup>th</sup> November 2019 and valid until the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020.
2. Funding will be available to assist coaches / officials to further their skills, qualifications, personal development or education in their chosen sport. This may include attending training courses, events, competitions or mentoring with other coaches / officials.
3. Recipients must apply in writing to ParaFed Canterbury requesting funding. This will be paid out with a maximum 50% in the first half of the year and the remaining amount to be paid out in the second half of the year unless exceptional circumstances are presented.
4. Scholarship recipients will be able to access their funding between February and November 2020. Unused funds at the end of this period will not be carried over to the next year unless previously identified by the athlete and approved by ParaFed Canterbury.
5. Recipients maybe required run coaching / officiating sessions for ParaFed Canterbury through the year.
6. Recipients maybe requested to assist ParaFed Canterbury at events; such as fundraising and official functions, sports days, junior sports club activities and guest speaking appointments.
7. ParaFed Canterbury reserves the right to use information and photographs of any recipient for promotional and media purposes.
8. When appropriate, coaches/officials are encouraged to promote being supported by ParaFed Canterbury in any interviews, media articles and relevant social media posts.
9. Recipients must behave in an appropriate manner befitting a person representing ParaFed Canterbury. If a recipient brings the organisation or sport into disrepute their Academy Programme / Scholarship Programme status and funding will be reviewed.
